LADDER RULES

1. Players are placed in groups of four, five or six by the Ladder Manager according to their N.T.R.P. rating. Group numbers will be determined by the total number of entries.
2. Every 5 weeks (depending on Statutory Holidays, etc.), the Ladder Manager will email the boxes to all participants, including player contact information so that players can arrange matches with one another.
3. **Players must book courts for Ladder matches as regular one (1) hour court booking. Court fees apply to all Ladder Matches with court fees being equally shared by the players.**
4. Both players must supply a can of new balls at the beginning of each match. At the conclusion of the match, the losing player keeps the used balls and the winner keeps the new balls.
5. Each match will be played as one pro-set (**no-ad scoring**). The first player to win 8 games wins the match. At 7-7, a regular tiebreak (first to 7 points, win by 2 or more) will be played. When the first buzzer sounds, the game that is being played may be completed. Once that game is completed, the match is over. If a new game has not started before the first buzzer sounds, then the match is deemed to be complete at that point. A game or tiebreaker must be finished for it to count towards the final score.
6. Players arriving more than 15 minutes late are subject to default.
7. Points will be awarded in the following manner.
Win = 4 Points Tie = 2 Points Loss = 1 Point Default = 0 Points
Play All Matches in a Session = 4 Bonus Points
8. Injured or ill players, or those away for an extended period of time must notify the Ladder Manager to allow other players in the box to be notified as the player(s) may be subject to a default win.
9. Depending on the size of the box, every player must play a minimum of 2 matches each session to remain eligible to stay in the ladder. Those who don't are subject to removal without refund, but can re-apply after missing a minimum of one (1) session.
10. Players who have difficulty reaching opponents or arranging a game with another player, must inform the Ladder Manager prior to registering a default.
11. New players can enter the ladder at the beginning of each period. They will be placed into groups according to their N.T.R.P. rating. The Ladder Fee will not be pro-rated.
12. At the end of each session month, the Ladder Manager will draw up new boxes. The top player and possibly the second player in each box may be promoted to a higher box. The bottom player and possibly the second from the bottom may be relegated to a lower box. However, if a player appears to be placed in a box significantly too low or too high, he or she may be promoted/relegated by more than one box.
13. In the event of ties for 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th place, the applicable prize pool for those Places will be added together and then equally divided amongst the affected players.
14. Players are responsible for recording their own scores on the Ladder Sheet, located on the board in the tennis gallery at Mayfair Parkway, or on the board in the main hallway near the change rooms at Mayfair East. Scores will be counted for each player as they are recorded on the ladder sheet. Unrecorded scores will not be counted.
15. The Ladder Manager settles all disputes.
16. Players who do not play or show for a scheduled/booked match will pay 100% of the court fee, unless, the other player chooses to buy the court or the court is put up for sale and bought by another Member.
