

New Member Policies for Squash | Phase III:

- All Members must leave the court at the end of their court booking.
- Members can only enter the court after the other player has exited the court.
- Each court has a designated waiting area indicated by floor marker and signage. Members should wait in this area until the other player has left court to assist in social distancing.
- Disinfecting wipes have been placed at each court entrance, please wipe doors handles before and after using the courts.
- Solo play is allowed.
- Singles and Doubles Play is only permitted between players who have been living in the same household for a consecutive 2 weeks or 14 days prior.
- On Court Coaching and Private Lessons are allowed when social distancing can be accommodated.
- Two players may engage in on-court drills and/or conditioned games so long as the players maintain a distance of at least 2 metres at all times.
- Courts are marked in zones that delineate each player's individual area designed to maintain a distance of 6' between players.
- Players may engage in the above on-court activities only within a pod of a maximum of 6 players. A player can only be in one pod. Pods will be administered by Head Squash Pro.
- Each player should bring a game ball onto the court, and each should warm up their own ball. Each player will only serve with, and touch with their hand or body, their respective ball. Upon switching servers, the player will retrieve their ball and place it into their pocket while their opponent prepares to serve with his or her ball.
- Masks can be taken off only when the player is on court.
- No walk-ons allowed. All courts must be booked via the Mayfair Clubs Online App prior to entering our facilities.
- Keep moving. There is no lingering or gathering allowed in our facilities.
- Members are not allowed access to areas indicated as "Not in Service."
- Players should wash their hands with soap and water before and after play.
- Players must refrain from touching the walls, floors, and glass of the squash court.
- The Club will continue to evaluate these policies and reserves the right to modify as needed without prior notice.
- Due to member and staff safety concerns, the Club reserves the right to suspend the membership of anyone found to be in violation of these rules and policies.

The policies above apply to our Phase III re-opening. We will revise policies and open additional services for members for Phase II when we are given the go ahead from our local governing bodies and health agencies.
